Format

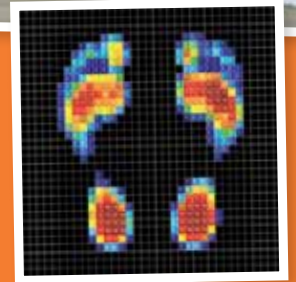

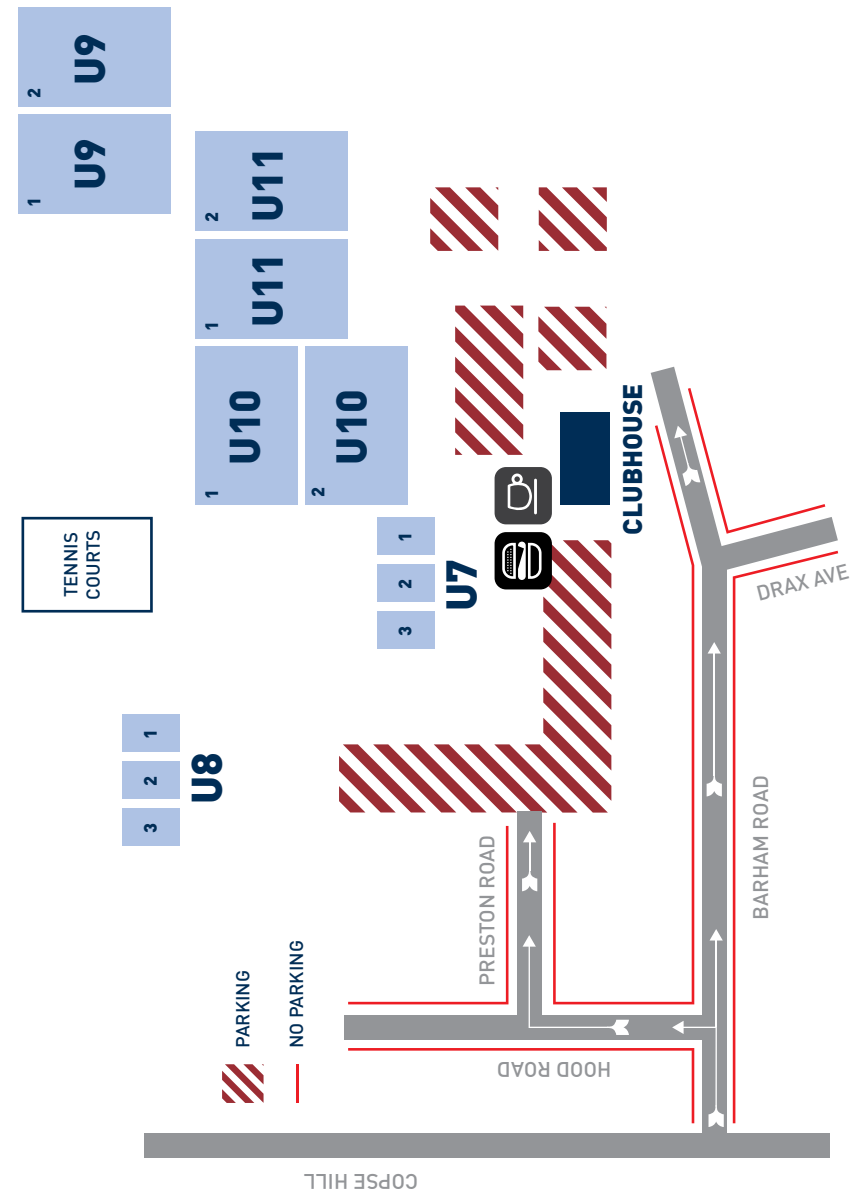

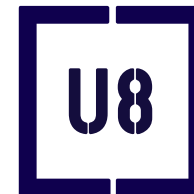
