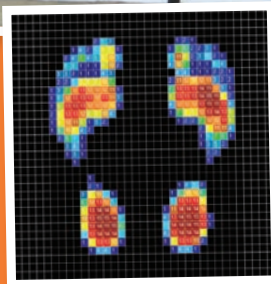

Child Welfare

In line with recent changes in legislation and best practice the RFU has had to publish guidelines on the photography of children. These are set out on page 36 of 'Policy and procedures for the welfare of young people in Rugby Union', which has been distributed by the RFU to clubs.

Please draw to the attention of all of your player's parents/guardians that in entering their children in this festival they implicitly agree and accept that: a) Photographic images may be taken of their son/daughter, during the normal course of rugby activity, by accredited photographers and/or other parents/ guardians.

b) These images may be used in the press or in Club/County/ RFU publicity, in line with the RFU guidelines.

Our Child Welfare Officer will be available all day at the festival and should be consulted if any particular photography is thought to be inappropriate or if there are any other Child Welfare issues.

Format

The competition for each age group will be split into two or more age leagues of five teams. Each team will play three or four games to decide league positions and the first two in each league will play final deciders for the Festival Cup and Plate competitions with 3rd and 4th place deciders for some age groups.

Team registration and briefing

Please make sure you register your team by **09:30** at your age group control tent. Required Information needed is: **Team name, player's names and date of birth, coach's name and referee's name.**

Gumshields must be worn by all players in age groups u9 and above.

Referee's briefing

The Referees briefing will be at **09:45** by your age group control.

Food and drink at the Clubhouse

Matches start at 10.00

The rules of the RFU continuum will apply and a quick guide to these is set out later in this programme. Please help us keep the day moving smoothly by having your team together and ready to play when called. Any team found with an unregistered player (therefore uninsured) or one out of the correct Continuum age group will be disqualified from the festival. The referee's decision is final concerning matters on the pitch and its immediate surrounds. In all other matters the festival organiser's decision will be final.

League points and standings

Three points for a win, one for a draw and none for a loss. Tied league positions will be decided by most tries scored, least tries conceded and finally the toss of a coin.

Prizes

There will be a trophy for the overall winners and the "plate" winners of each age group plus medals for the U7s and U8s.

First Aid

First Aid kits are available at the pitch side and there are qualified first aiders and paramedics on site.

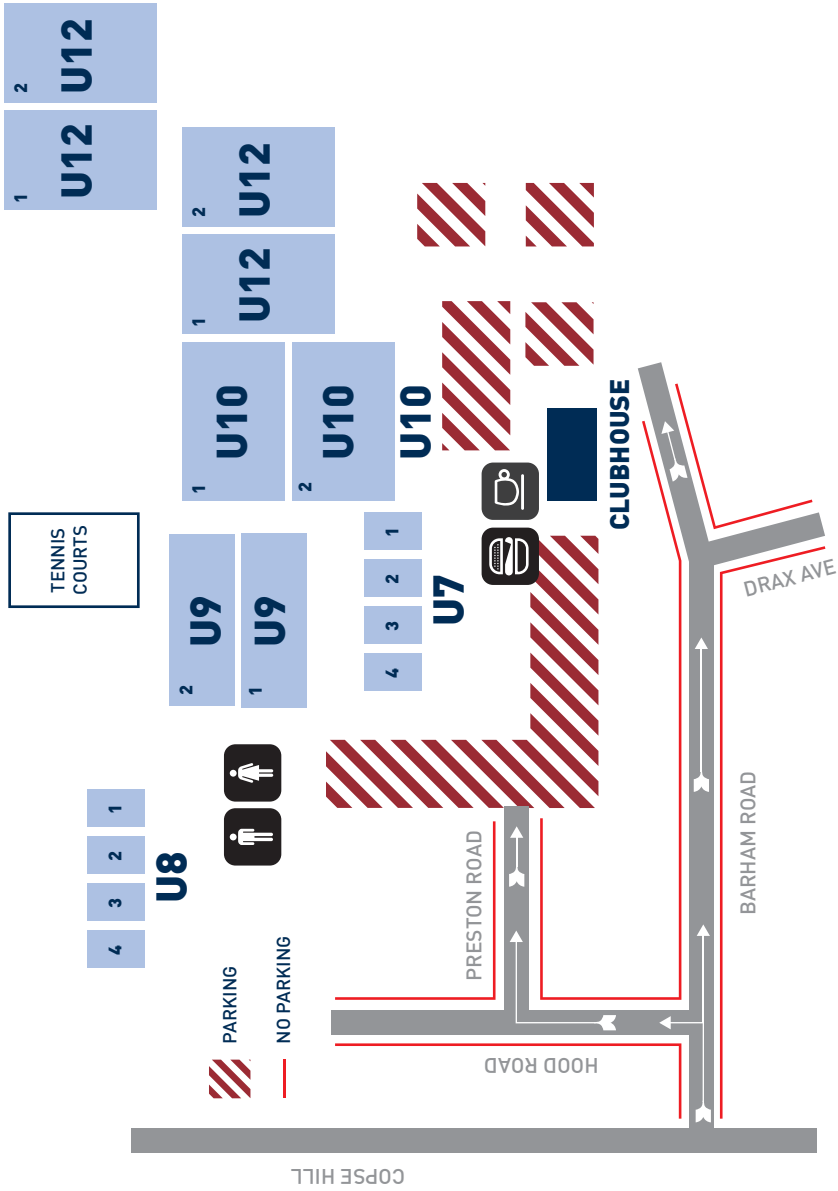
